- from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Expo Village (Ragusa Off) – collection of bibs and race packages + new entries

Date: Saturday 28th March

Times:

- Collection of bibs and new entries from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Circus Maximus
- Resort opening from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Circus Maximus
- Start of the race from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. (staggered starts)

RULES OF PARTICIPATION

The Fun Race is the non-competitive 4.5 km race combined with the Run Rome The Marathon. Participation is permitted at any age. In order to participate, you must read and accept these rules in full.

FRAUDULENT PARTICIPATION

The registered person is responsible for the ownership and custody of the race bib, acquiring the right to use all the services mentioned in these regulations and subsequently announced. a) Any persons who, without proper registration, participate without a bib, in addition to being held responsible for damage to persons or property, including to themselves, may be liable to the criminal sanctions provided for the crime of "theft" (Article 624 Italian Penal Code). b) Any persons who, without proper registration, participate with a forged bib number or in any case not in accordance with the number assigned, in addition to being liable as indicated above, will incur sports sanctions and may also be liable to the criminal penalties provided for the crime of "theft" (Article 624 Penal Code), or, alternatively, for the crime of "fraud" (Article 640 Penal Code). In cases a) and b), the participants may be liable to the sanctions provided for the crime of "Non-Compliance with the Provisions of the Authorities" (Article 650 of the Italian Penal Code).
